Subject: **EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANT (EMPG)**
PROJECTED AWARD AMOUNT FOR 2011

In view of the projected fiscal support of emergency management programs by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), a baseline of \$6,082,548 has been established for local and state programs in FFY-11. In keeping with Wisconsin Emergency Management (WEM) policy, this grant award will be distributed on the basis of no less than a 2/3 allocation for support of local programs, and approximately a 1/3 level of support for the state program.

WEM has established a distribution formula with a base of \$12,000.00 for each tribe. Additional funds have been awarded based on a 75/25 percent basis for population and area respectively.

WEM's projected FFY-11 award amount for your Tribe is at Attachment 1. This grant award is contingent upon WEM receiving the same amount as the 2010 EMPG award and acceptance of WEM's FY-11 EMPG application. If funding is less there will be a prorated allocation decrease based on our distribution formula. If the funding is greater there will be a prorated allocation increase based on our distribution formula.

Please keep in mind that tribes are reimbursed on actual expenditures incurred for the salary and fringe benefits of the tribal emergency management director, those in direct support of the plan of work activities, and as identified in the 2011 EMPG application. EMPG funding is limited to 50% of the identified salary, fringe benefits, and items in your Emergency Management budget from your EMPG application, or the formula amount, whichever is less.

Tribal governments and emergency management offices should be advised that Wisconsin Emergency Management remains committed to the established grant formulas.
