Governor Doyle Statement on Storm Damage

MADISON – Governor Jim Doyle today issued the following statement regarding storms and high winds that have damaged communities throughout southern Wisconsin:

“The damage from yesterday’s storms in the Village of Eagle and communities in southern Wisconsin is devastating.

“Recovery efforts are already underway through the work of state and local officials, and we are working hard to get an accurate assessment of the damage and the resources needed to help speed our efforts. Tomorrow I will be touring the area with General Don Dunbar to survey the damage and meet face to face with local officials and residents.

“Despite the significant property damage that occurred, we are thankful that people made it through the storm safely, with no reported fatalities or serious injuries.

“I’d like to thank everyone who has come together to help their neighbors and friends during this tough situation. Our thoughts and prayers are with all those affected by these damaging storms.”
